

# Two time Australian champion returns to the Moree Show

MOREE car enthusiasts, it's time to get the motors up and running for this year's 125th annual Moree Show Tyrepower Demolition Derby, to be held at the showgrounds Sunday evening, April 26.

Past winner and two time Australian Demolition Derby Champion, Errol Carter, said he wouldn't miss this year's event for the world and encouraged other locals to 'harden up' and have a bash in the derby.

He's also looking to regain the crowning glory from last year's Moree Show Demolition Derby winner Danny Byers.

"It's a great, fun event filled with adrenalin - I'm really glad we have the opportunity here in Moree to host a demolition derby - it's a fantastic event," Mr Carter said.

He said there was a huge amount of interest in the event after last year's Moree Show and that it was great to see the young ones taking an interest.

"My advice for anyone who saw the event last year and is thinking about having a go, just do it - buy an old wreck and have a go - you can build a car in a weekend and it's extremely satisfying once you're out there on the night."

Mr Carter said he loved the free reign of the event.

"You can virtually do anything - it's great anger management," he joked.

Event steward Greg Burey said he was looking forward to the Tyrepower Demolition Derby, saying it was a really good, action-packed spectator sport.

"We've got a 30-car limit for this year and have already had a lot of interest so I urge people to get their entry forms in quickly so they can get a run and a chance to win the \$1000 cash prize," Mr Carter said.

The eagerly anticipated Header Demolition Derby may however be in jeopardy, with too few headers nominated.
