

# Wood chopping returns to the Moree Show

WOOD chopping will make a return to this year's Moree Show.

While it will only be an exhibition this year there is the hope that competition will again return in the near future.

Steward David Watts said the show committee were hoping by bringing it back, there would be renewed interest.

Six woodchoppers will bring 40 blocks with them and hold exhibitions throughout the day on Sunday, April 26, and may even have a mini competition between themselves. There will also be another four people travelling to the show to compete in chainsaw races.

"This is a first I know of for the show," Mr Watts said.

"It should be interesting."

He said last year's show was such a success the committee wanted to build on that achievement and bring more to the show this year.

"We've got a young, enthusiastic committee and it's the 125th year so we need to make it bigger and better and step up a gear.
